2. All Friendships Based on Position

- a. Peer friends - same age
- b. Abraham's position
 - Gen 22:12 fear of the Lord
 - establish your position
 - * levels of authority
 - * occupy rightful position
 - * living your position
 - * God the Creator, person the created
- c. Relationships determined by position

3. Trust Determining Factor to Depth of Friendship

- a. Scripture fulfilled
 - Abraham believed God
 - God counted that trust for righteousness
- b. Trustworthy
 - Dependability based on trustworthy
- c. Trust built over time
 - God made a covenant with Abraham
- d. Biblical marriage
 - covenant first with God
 - covenant with each other
 - earthly marriage more often seen as social & legal contract
 - * contracts based on distrust

4. Commitment to Friend's Goodwill
Show strength of commitment
- a. 1 Sam 18 Jonathan sees David's fight with Goliath
 - soul brothers
 - Jonathan makes covenant with David
 - Jonathan put his robe (heir to the King) on David
 - b. Friends are givers in the relationship
 - c. Commitment shows maturity
5. Quality of Friendship Based on Mutual Openness
- a. Listening heart
 - b. Honesty
 - c. Job's 3 friends
 - * "with friends like them, who needs any enemies"
 - * they accused Job, but did not listen to Job
 - d. Friends "sharpen" each other
 - "iron sharpening iron"
 - e. Heb 10: 25 not forsaking assembly of ourselves together
 - provoke another to good works in love
 - exhorting each other
 - f. Biblical worldview brings Christians to a decision
