1. Introduction

- a. Conclusion Rom 2:1 Therefore mankind is not excused from sin & God's judgement
- b. Mankind has a problem - sin nature
 - each human has both good & evil intents
 - each human instinctively knows how to lie & avoid the truth
 - each human has desire to deny God & not keep God in knowledge
- c. Psalm 1 downward to paganism
 - willful blindness
 - deliberate reject God
 - wicked beliefs
 - immoral behavior

- d. Greek & Roman civilizations full of Biblical sins

2. Fruit of Righteousness

- a. Debased mind can no longer discern good or evil
 - reprobate minds
- b. Sinner's ~~dev~~ devastation revealed
 - filled with unrighteousness
 - depravity of all humans
- c. Specific 23 sins listed
 - all these listed normally condemned by almost ^{all} human societies past & present

3. Judgement of Unrighteousness
 - a. People who know righteous judgment of God
 - these are people who know better
 - people who know God & good & evil, wrong & right
 - b. Awareness of judgment
 - justice is about fairness
 - even children know when their sense of justice violated
 - "It's not fair"
 - c. Awareness of death
 - anyone practicing unrighteous acts worthy of condemnation
 - * murder penalty is death sentence
 - * other crime penalties involve loss of freedom
 - aware that God's judgment deserve living death (dead men eternally walking)
 - d. Willful unrighteousness
 - sinners continue to practice sins with defiant fist to God
 - sinners also approve of others doing the same
 - their evil companions
