- a. Transition in history of church from Jerusalem to Antioch
- b. Change, spreading from Jews to Gentiles - see Acts 1:8
- c. Gospel went into all the world
- d. Barnabus - son of consolation (encourager)
 - Barnabus encouraging Christians
 - x Acts 9:27 introduced to Apostles
 - x sent to Antioch (Gentiles)
 - x Acts 15:38 Mark to Cyprus
- e. ^{Barnabus} Described as - Acts 11:24
 - good man
 - full of Holy Spirit
 - full of faith

2. Mark of a bishop/elder

- a. ~~Mark of a bishop/elder~~ 1 Tim 3:1-7
- b. Married to same wife / one woman man
- c. Rules his own home well -
 - testimony from his children
 - home leadership qualities
- d. Character qualities
 - good behavior
 - able to teach
 - reality based thinking - sober
 - not greedy for money
 - not violent
 - not drunk
 - experienced in Christian life
 - not full of pride

3. What is meant by "full of Spirit"
- a. Fruit of Spirit - Gal 5:22-23
 - b. Controlled by Holy Spirit
 - Gal 5:16 Walk in the Spirit
 - Gal 5:22 Live in the Spirit
 - Gal 5:18 Led by the Spirit
 - c. Barnabus led by the Spirit
 - Acts 9:26-27 ~~Apostles~~ ^{disciples} afraid of Paul, but Barnabus brought Saul to the Apostles
 - d. Barnabus led by the Spirit - Antioch
 - Acts 11:23, 25-26 Barnabus saw God moving among the Gentiles
 - x he went to find Saul in Tarsus
 - x he brought Saul to Antioch
 - x he knew Saul was the Apostle sent to the Gentiles
 - e. Barnabus led by the Spirit - Mark
 - Acts 12:25 John Mark came with Barnabus & Saul from Jerusalem to Antioch
 - Acts 13:5 John Mark on team on First Missionary Journey
 - Acts 13:13 John Mark returns to Jerusalem
 - Acts 15:36-38 Barnabus wanted to take John Mark on Second Missionary Journey
 - Acts 15:38 Paul sharply disagreed
 - Acts 15:39 Barnabus took John Mark to Cyprus
 - 2 Tim 4:11 Paul's last letter asks to bring ~~Timothy~~ Mark to Rome
 - We now have Mark's gospel
