**In Exodus 25–28, we have the blueprint of the tabernacle structure.**

#### THE BLUEPRINT OF THE TABERNACLE STRUCTURE

1. Outer Courtyard—150 ft. x 75 ft. x 7.5 ft.
2. Brazen Altar—7.5 ft. x 7.5 ft. x 4.5 ft.  
*Place where all the burnt sacrifices and offerings were made*
3. Laver—4 ft. x 4 ft.  
*Place where the priests washed their hands and feet*
4. The Tabernacle—45 ft. x 15 ft.  
*Divided into two rooms: The Holy Place and Holy of Holies*
5. The Holy Place—15 ft. x 30 ft.  
*Included a solid gold Golden Lampstand and Table of Showbread*
6. Holy of Holies—15 ft. x 15 ft.  
*The most sacred spot where the Ark of the Covenant was located*

**When you come to chapters 35 and 36 of Exodus, you are looking at the budget.**
