1. Introduction

- a. Paul writing to his spiritual son Timothy
- b. Spiritual resources
 - Word of God
 - prayer
- c. No prayer - no spiritual power

2. Priority of Prayer

- a. Timothy called to ministry
- b. Strong teaching - prayer
 - exhortation
 - need God's help
- c. How Christians pray
 - supplication - asking, requests
 - * liberally ask God
 - prayers - devotion to God
 - * adore God * worship God
 - intercession - asking for others
 - thanksgiving - thanking God
 - * Paul asked, pastors ask, "Pray for us"
- d. Who to pray for
 - for all people
 - for government rulers
 - for all having authority
- e. Why to pray
 - to live quiet & peaceable life
 - living in godliness & reverence
 - prayer life good & acceptable in sight of God

3. Purpose of God

- a. Salvation of all
 - God desires all men to be saved
 - God wants all to knowledge of the truth
 - * 1 Tim 4:10 Savior of all men
- b. Knowledge of the truth
 - spiritual understanding (discernment)

4. Provision of Christ

a. Truth # 1: One God

b. Truth # 2: One Mediator between God
& man

- mediator the man Christ Jesus
* Jesus is the "God Man"
