1. Introduction

- a. Remember Memorial Day of our fallen soldiers
- b. Table in church "In Remembrance of Me"
 - celebrating Lord's Supper
 - Lk 22:19-20

2. Lord gave thanks for Communion bread

- Lk 22:19 Remember Christ
- a. "This is my body given for you" (Mt 26:26-28, Mk 14:22-24)
- b. "This cup is the New Testament (covenant) of my blood"

3. Jesus gave His broken body for

us
a. "This is my body..."

b. "In remembrance of Me"

- Jesus flogged, whipped, beaten
- He got crown of thorns with blood coming down His face

- His back got flogged with bleeding back everywhere

c. "My body which is given for you..."

- In 10:11 Good Shepherd who gives His life for His sheep
- In 10:17-18 Jesus lays down His life of Himself & the power to take up His life again

- In 19:11 Pilate could not have power against Jesus unless that power given from above

4. Jesus gave His blood (His life)
- a. "This cup is the New Covenant
in My blood"
 - b. "Jesus blood shed for you"
 - c. New Covenant Heb 8:8-10
 - Jer 31:31-34
 - Ezek 36:26-27

5. Jesus wants us to do things
in remembrance of Him
- 1 Cor 11:24-26 (vs 23 also)
 - a. Looking backwards to Jesus
death, burial, & resurrection
(1 Cor 15:3-4)
 - b. Looking forward to Jesus
coming back again
 - c. Communion/Lord's Supper
unique for Christians in
the church, "until He comes"
