2. Historical facts

a. David rebuilt Tabernacle Tent in Jerusalem

b. Solomon (David's son) built 1st temple at highest point in Jerusalem

c. In later years Solomon sinned worshipping false gods.

- Tophet at southern end of Jerusalem where Kidron Valley & Hinnom Valley meet

- Tophet where parents burned their children worshipping Molech

 - Person who has clean hands
 - Who may stand in God's holy place?
