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1. Introduction

a. Words

- no respect of persons - no partiality

b. God judges all evil people according to their actions

- Jews will be judged in the Law

- Gentiles will be judged outside of the Law

* all people in past ancient times
& in all societies have general moral code

2. Judgment of Hardened People (vs 5)

a. Case against hypocrite

- they have hard hearts

- they have heart that they will not repent of their sin(s)

- impenitent means will not repent

b. Reality of God's judgment

- their bad actions add up more anger from God

- 2 Sam 12:7,9 Nathan points finger at King David's sin of murder

3. Impartiality of God (vs. 6-10)

a. God will give judgement to each person according to their actions

b. God's judgments based on 4 principles

- according to the truth

- according to person's actions

- without partiality

- according to God's gospel

3c. God will render (pay) just payment

d. Hypocrite Jew judged like heathen
Gentiles
- both judged the same for sin(s)
- terms of judgment

* Rom 3: 10-11 None righteous

e. Those who seek (look) the Lord
will find Him

- those who continue patiently
- those who work good

f. Those who seek their own way

- obey unrighteousness
- receive wrath, tribulation, &
anguish

4. Triumph of God's Justice (vs. 11)

a. No partiality with God

- God does not play favorites
- Jms 2:9 showing partiality commits sin

b. Justice of God

- God makes fair judgments
- 2 Chron 19:7 God doesn't take bribes

c. - The soul that sins will
surely die (Ezek 18:4)

d. God is immutable

- God does not change
- Rom 6:23 wages of sin is death

e. Nature of man

- Rom 3:23 For all have sinned
- Jms 2:10 stumble in one point
of the Law is guilty of breaking
→ all parts of the Law

f. God's instruction

- Jms 4:8 Come close to God
* clean your hands
* purify your hearts
