 - Rom 6:1 Shall we continue in sin? so that grace can abound (multiply)?
 - Rom 5:20 God's working * where sin multiplied, God's grace did much more abound

5. Jesus presents Himself
- a. Jn 3:11 "Truthfully I say to you, we speak what we do know. And testify what we have seen. And you do not receive our witness."
- b. Jn 3:17 Because God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him may be saved.
- c. Jn 3:18 whoever believes on Him is not condemned. But whoever does not believe is condemned already. Because ^{the} person has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- d. Jer 10:10 But the Lord is the true God. He is the living God...
