1. Introduction

a. Romans is logical writing about God's salvation

b. Humans born in sin, live by sin, & die due to sin

- People have fallen away from God's grace because of sin
- God is holy (1 Pet 1:16)

c. Three truths

2. Determination in Scripture

a. Both Jews & Gentiles that they are all under sin

b. All people are under sin

- several quotations from Old Testament

* Ps 14:1-3; 53:1-3

* None (no one) righteous

c. All have gone astray

- there is none who does good
- all we like sheep have gone astray (Is 53:6)

* we have turned to his own way

3. Declaration of Sin

a. Sin affects human lips (speech)

- words compared as poison

- mouth full of cursing/bitterness

b. Sin affects living actions

- feet swift to shed blood (murder)

- destruction & misery

- way of peace unknown to them

- Is 59:7-8

3c. Sin affects their heart (motivation)
- no fear of God in their sight

4. Destruction

a. Judge's sentence: guilty world

- every mouth may be stopped

* human excuses

* human accusations

* human rationalizations

* human justifications

- only God's Law will matter

- all the world guilty before God

b. Judge's sentence: unjustified flesh

- no person justified by works of the Law

* cannot earn being justified in God's sight

- Learning Law of Moses

* people receive knowledge of sin

c. Judge's sentence: condemning knowledge

- justified? made just/holy in God's sight

- Eph 2:9 (salvation) not of works lest any man should boast

- Rom 6:23 Wages of sin is death

- Gal 2:16 Human not justified by the works of the Law
