1. Introduction

a. History of the world can be changed by actions of one man

b. Therefore

- reconciliation: made friends from enemies

- Enemies of God when one man sinned

* Adam actions door through which sin entered the world

* death entered through sin

2. Ruin of Mankind

a. Adam sinned - Gen 3:6

- 1 Jn 2:16 the world

* lust of the flesh

* lust of the eyes

* pride of life

- 1 Tim 2:14

* woman was deceived

* but man (Adam) was not deceived

* Adam bears responsible for sin entering the world

b. Sin's progression (Jms 1:13-15)

- person tempted when enticed & drawn away by their own lust

- lust conceives & gives birth sin

- sin grows, & finishes with harvest of seeds of death

2c. Adam's Sin Revealed (Gen 3:8-13)

- Adam & Eve hiding
- "God, where are you?"
- Adam's shame, "I was naked & afraid & hid myself."
- ~~to~~ God, "Who told you that you were naked?"
- God, "Have you eaten of the tree?"

d. ~~the~~ Blame Game

- Gen 3:12 the woman whom you gave me
- Gen 3:13 the snake enticed & deceived me

3. Reign of Death

- Sin ruled in time between time of life between Adam to Moses (book of Genesis)
- But law of the Covenant given to Moses
 - often called law of Moses
 - summarized in Ten Commandments (Exod 20:2-17)
 - written in books of Exod, Leviticus, Numbers, & Deut
- Every person born into sin of Adam

4. Reach of Grace

- Free gift (vs 15)
 - gift of the grace of God
 - one man Jesus Christ
- Rom 5:8 God's love shown
 - Christ died for all people
 - While all people were still ^{sinner}s
- God's gift of freedom in justification (vs. 16)
- God's abundance of grace (vs 17)
gift of righteousness - the one gift of grace Jesus Christ
- One man's (Jesus) righteous act results in justification of life (vs)
