a. Verses Ps 110:1, 2 Sam 7:12

b. Whose son is Jesus?

- Genealogy in Mt 1:1-16

* legal descendant of King David & King Solomon

- Genealogy in Lk 3:23-38

* bloodline descendant of King David & his son Nathan

c. God's covenant with King David

- 2 Sam 7:11-16

* partial fulfillment in King Solomon

* complete fulfillment of this prophecy in Jesus Son of God

2. Question 1: Who is Jesus' father?

a. Early teaching in Judaism

- Messiah is son of David

b. Obvious Jesus of Nazareth

is 100% human

- today Judaism still teaches that Messiah is "son of David"

c. Pharisees given thought

provoking question about David

- Lk 20:41, Mk 12:35-36, Mt 22:41-45

- If David calls Him Lord, then how can He be his son?

2d. Ps 110:1 "The Lord (YHWH) said unto my Lord (Adoni), "sit at My right hand until I make your enemies Your footstool."

- quoted in New Testament
* Mt 22:44; Mk 12:36, 16:19;
Lk 20:42-43, Acts 2:34-35;
Col 3:1; Heb 1:13,

3. New Testament Interpretation

a. Mk 12:36-37 Jesus says,
- "David Himself said by the Holy Spirit ... David therefore himself calls Him Lord

b. Mk 16:19 Jesus returns back to heaven sitting at right hand of God

c. Acts 2:34 David has not ascended to heaven
- Acts 1:9 while speaking as they looked, He was taken up & a cloud received Him (Jesus)
* only Jesus ascended

d. Col 3:1 ... above, where Jesus sits on God's right hand

e. Heb 1:13 But which to any angels said ~~He~~ He (God) at any time? sit on My right hand?

4. Jesus clearly explains

a. Jn 10:31 I and My Father are one

b. Jn 10:33 Jews answered, For a good work we don't stone you, but for blasphemy. Because you being a man make yourself God.
