Keeping God First in the New Year

Text: Exodus 20:1–3

"And God spake all these words, saying, 2 I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me." (Exodus 20:1-3)

INTRODUCTION

"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matthew 6:33)

B. The _____ of God

HE IS SELF-EXISTENT

"Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me." (Isaiah 43:10)

HE IS ETERNAL AND HAD NO BEGINNING

"Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God." (Psalm 90:2)

HE IS SOVEREIGN

2. RESPOND TO HIS

A. An Intervention of

GOD SAW THE NEED OF HIS PEOPLE

"And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; 8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites." (Exodus 3:7–8)

"For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

GOD MET THE NEED OF HIS PEOPLE

"And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 12 I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God. 13 And it came to pass, that at even the quails came up, and covered the camp: and in the morning the dew lay round about the host." GOD REDEEMED THEM BY HIS GRACE

B. To Loving

WE MUST TURN FROM ALL OTHERS

WE MUST TRUST ONLY IN HIM

"The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people: 8 But because the LORD loved you," (Deuteronomy 7:7-8a)

"Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins" (1 John 4:10)

CONCLUSION

HOW TO KEEP GOD FIRST IN 2025

- 1. Determine to trust Him "Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: But we will remember the name of the LORD our God." (Psalm 20:7)
- Determine to cast down any other gods
 "Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;" (2 Corinthians 10:5)

3. Determine to meet with Him daily

"And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed." (Mark 1:35)

- Keep a Journal
- Meditate on God's attributes
- Word studies
- Determine to Pray and Fast

"And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting." (Mark 9:29)

4. Determine to attend all church services

"And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." (Hebrews 10:24–25) 5. Determine to be active in a connection group "For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:" (Ephesians 4:12)
