INTRODUCTION

- Solomon, one of the wisest men to ever live, said in Ecclesiastes 3:1, "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven.
- Then in verse 7 he wrote: "...a time to keep silence, and a time to speak."
- For most of us, we would be in much better shape if we could discern those seasons a little better! James 1:19 swift to hear, slow to speak
- Although there are definitely times, we would be better off to remain silent, our text reminds us that there are times when speaking a word in "due season" is not only essential, but it can also be eternally rewarding!

SIX THINGS WE WILL BE Glad WE SAID

- A Word of commendation (Ephesians 4:29) good for edifying
- minister grace to hearer
- A Word of compassion (Jude 22) - making a difference
~~Faithful are words~~
- A Word of caution (Proverbs 27:5) - open rebuke
Faithful are wounds of friend
- A Word of contrition (Matthew 5:23-24, reconcile Ephesians 4:26-32) do not allow sun to go down on your anger - reconcile
- A Word of charity (1 Corinthians 13:1-8, unselfish love
1 John 4:17-19, Psalm 107:2) - perfect love, redeemed of the Lord
- A Word of commitment (Romans 10:9-13, confess & believe
1 John 5:11-13, John 1:12) believe on name of Jesus has eternal life
